## **2021 RLS Speed Pit Code of Conduct**

Parent/Guardian code of conduct is a part of the Speed Pit Rules and guidelines, if not followed, suspensions will be enforced to the people involved and the entire race team they are affiliated with!

\*I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct at the Track with any driver, crew member, official, or spectators such as booing, taunting, or using profanity, & hand gestures.

\*I will not engage in any unsportsmanlike conduct on any form of Social Media.

As a Parent/Guardian, I agree to the following:

- \*I will learn the rules and the policies of the Speed Pit and abide by them at all times.
- \*I will teach my child to race by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- \*I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect, and courtesy to all drivers, crew members, officials, and spectators at every race.
- \*I will not encourage any bad behaviors or practices that would endanger the health or well being of any other person.
- \*I will encourage my child to treat other racers, crew members, officials, and spectators with respect.
- \*I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a race.
- \*I will inform the officials of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- \*I will respect the officials and their authority during races and will never question, discuss, or confront the officials during any race. If needed, I will take time to speak with the officials after all races are completed for the evening with a Official.
- \*If a driver would like to change classes other than their age group, the driver or parent may appeal to the Officials for permission to do so. The Officials will consider based on the same information as previously stated.
